

The brilliant fall colors in Wisconsin's Door County attract tourists from near and far, and this area has received a fair share of accolades for its impressive fall foliage. Door County has been singled out by such travel authorities as Trip Advisor and Travel + Leisure as one of the country's top fall foliage destinations. Wherever you look, you'll be surrounded by eye candy on this gorgeous Wisconsin peninsula.

## Day 1: Green Bay ~ Home of The Packers!

Depart Minneapolis for Beautiful Door County! Today's travel will take us across Wisconsin to enjoy the beautiful fall foliage. You will enjoy a drive to the top of Rib Mountain in Wausau. Then the group will arrive at the home of the Green Bay Packers  $\sim$  Lambeau Field. After an hour included tour of this historic facility, enjoy dinner on your own at Lambeau's on-site restaurant  $\sim$  1919 Kitchen & Tap. Monday night football will be playing, so we will be in on all the action right there! Then it's time to head to your local Green Bay hotel to turn in for the night.

### Day 2: Rowley's Bay Resort

This morning after an included breakfast, you will board the motorcoach and head to the National Railroad Museum in Green Bay. See the Union Pacific Big Boy, the world's largest steam locomotive; General Dwight D. Eisenhower's World War II command train; and the Lake Mitchell, a Pullman sleeping car built in 1924. Then it's time to head up into Door County! Door County is a 70-mile peninsula that juts into Lake Michigan, sometimes known as the "Inland Cape Cod". There are fruit orchards, antique shops, and picturesque little fishing villages that line the coast. Our first stop will be in Sturgeon Bay for lunch on your own at a local restaurant. Then it's on to the venerable Door Peninsula Winery where fruit wines are the specialty. After an informative tour of the winery, you will then be able to sample over 40 different types of wine for free! You will then continue up to Rowley's Bay Resort where you will settle in for the next three nights.

## Day 3: Touring Door County & Fish Boil!

Enjoy an included Buffet Breakfast today. Your group continues on it's tour of the back roads of Door County. You will stop in Fish Creek for lunch on your own and some time to shop at Founder's Square, where there are some of the most amazing shops on the peninsula. This afternoon you will experience the beauty of the shores and bluffs on your way to Eagle Bluff Lighthouse, built in 1868. A guide will take you through the living quarters that are completely furnished from that era, where you'll learn about life in a lighthouse in the 1880's. Next, experience a taste of Door County at the Farm Market where you will sample some of Wisconsin's famous jams, jellies, relishes and chocolate covered cherries. Tonight, enjoy an included fish boil dinner! But first, enjoy a rousing historic talk by "Peter Rowley" who will entertain you with tales and stories of the settling of Rowley's Bay. Watch as your meal is prepared over an open fire and the "boil-over"! The fish you will be feasting on this evening comes right in at the dock daily at the nearby fishing village of Gills Rick.

Enjoy an included traditional Swedish meal with all the fixings.
