DAY 1- FLYING OFF TO WASHINGTON DC!

Meet at Terminal 2 at the MSP Airport to depart in the morning for your sojourn to the capital. Upon arrival, pick up your luggage (which will be checked for free) and meet your bus. You will then head to the historic area of Washington DC where you will enjoy lunch on your own before you begin your tour of Arlington National Cemetery, including the Tomb of the Unknowns, Kennedy graves & the Iwo-Jima Memorial. You will head to your hotel for the next four nights. Upon arrival, check into your Washington DC hotel and enjoy an included Welcome Dinner this evening.

DAY 2- TOURING WASHINGTON DC

After an (included) breakfast depart for a full-day tour of Washington DC. Some of the awe-inspiring sights on this fantastic tour will include the US Capital, The White House, National Archives, the Washington Monument, The Lincoln Memorial, FDR Memorial, Martin Luther King Jr National Memorial & the Korean and Viet Nam War Memorials. This evening enjoy dinner at local restaurant on your own.

DAY 3- MOUNT VERNON & HISTORIC GADSBY'S TAVERN

This morning, after an (included) breakfast head to George Washington's Mount Vernon Estate & Garden. Experience great American history at Mount Vernon. Then enjoy a relaxing (Included) 2:00 PM lunch/dinner at Historic Gadsby's Tavern where George Washington, John Adams, Thomas Jefferson and Alexander Hamilton once dined. Return to your hotel for the night for relaxation and dinner on your own.

DAY 4- THE SMITHSONIAN AND NATIONAL CATHEDRAL

Start your last day in our Nation's Capital with an included Continental Breakfast. This morning is at your leisure to explore the Smithsonian Institute, the Holocaust Museum, Spy Museum or maybe even the new Museum of the Bible. Lunch on your own can be had at the many cafeterias located inside the Smithsonian environs. Then enjoy a tour of The Washington DC National Cathedral. Enjoy this evening celebration of song in the beautiful church setting before heading back to your hotel.

DAY 5- HERSHEY AND GETTYSBURG

After your included breakfast, it's time to depart Washington DC. Heading towards Gettysburg, the group will take a swing through Hershey, Pennsylvania. Hershey is known for chocolate, so you will tour the chocolate welcome center and I'm sure, enjoy some chocolate! You will then check in to your Gettysburg hotel for the evening. Then it's time to depart for the Farnsworth House for an included dinner at one of the most historic restaurants in Gettysburg. The Farnsworth House served as a hospital during the Battle of Gettysburg, and you can still see the bullet holes on the walls. Settle back into history as you enjoy your last evening on tour.

After enjoying lunch on your own at Picket's Buffet, the group will then visit the site where President Lincoln gave the Gettysburg Address. Then it's time to head back to Baltimore to catch your evening flight. You will arrive late in Minneapolis at Terminal 2. Heading home you can reminisce about all the fun things you've done, the great sights you've seen & where your next group trip will take you!
